Executive Summary

Section 105.485.4 RSMo requires political subdivisions which adopt their own conflict of interest and financial disclosure procedures to adopt such procedures biennially.

Staff has prepared an ordinance which repeals and readopts the financial disclosure procedures of the City Code. No changes have been made to the current ordinance except to include council stipends as an exception to the reporting requirements contained in Sec. 2-125.1(a)(1).
