
## **Plan Objectives**

The IMP will help us target investments in the wastewater and stormwater programs to:

- Protect public health and public safety
- Improve quality of life
- Provide sustainable services for the future
- Achieve regulatory compliance
- Improve water quality in City streams







In 2017-18, the City of Columbia conducted a communitywide survey to obtain input from residents. These workshops were crticial to the planning process, as they helped our team develop an Integrated Management Plan that is tailored to the needs of our community. This plan was approved by the City Council in December 2018.

The City established a 5-Year IMP Action Plan that targeted future needs while implementing Capital Improvement Projects and necessary operation and maintenance activities.
