Re: Agreement with Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services for Healthy Families Program

Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign Amendment #2 to the Program Services Contract between the City of Columbia and the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services, for the Healthy Families program, in the amount of \$89,402.00 for the period of October 1, 2019 through September 30, 2020.

Discussion

This a renewal of a contract with the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services, for the Healthy Families program, an evidence-based community home visitation model serving at-risk pregnant women and families with young children. The goals of the program are to build and sustain community partnerships to systematically engage overburdened families in home visiting services; cultivate and strengthen nurturing parent child relationships; promote healthy childhood growth and development; and enhance family functioning by reducing risk and building protective factors. Authorization to enter this agreement will allow the program to operate at its current capacity.
