AN ORDINANCE

granting the issuance of a conditional use permit to Missouri Property Associates II, LLC to allow the establishment of a hair salon (barber and beauty shop) on property located at 607 Jackson Street in an M-OF (Mixed-Use Office) zoning district; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 29-6.4(m)(1) of the City Code, the Planning and Zoning Commission (hereinafter "Commission") held a public meeting and submitted a written recommendation to the City Council related to issuance of a conditional use permit; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the recommendation of the Commission along with the criteria set forth in Section 29-6.4(m)(2)(i) of the City Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council finds and determines that the criteria established in Section 29-6.4(m)(2)(i) of the City Code has been met and hereby grants the issuance of a conditional use permit to Missouri Property Associates II, LLC to allow the establishment of a hair salon (barber and beauty shop) on property located at 607 Jackson Street in an M-OF (Mixed-Use Office) zoning district, subject to the following conditions:

- a. The conditional use permit is granted to the property owner and shall be valid for the duration of the use or revocation of the permit. Any discontinuance of the use for a period of twelve (12) months or more or any change in the character of the use shall render the permit null and void and shall require the property owner to obtain a new conditional use permit.
- b. The property owner shall comply with the requirements of District M-OF and all other applicable regulations of any kind.
- c. The allowed use, per this conditional use permit, shall not create negative impacts on neighboring properties and rights-of-way, including but not limited to:


1. Lighting and glare beyond the property lines;
2. Excessive noise;
3. Dust and odor;
4. Excessive traffic not compatible with the surrounding neighborhood;
5. Storm water impacts; or
6. Physical appearance.

d. If any of the conditions of this conditional use permit are not complied with, the City Council, upon recommendation of the Commission following written notice and a noticed public hearing by the Commission, may in addition to revoking the permit, amend, alter, delete or add conditions to the permit.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
