Re: Authorizing a subrecipient monitoring agreement with Boone County, Missouri in relation to the acceptance and appropriation of funds for the 2019 Byrne Justice Assistance Grant (JAG)

## Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration an ordinance to authorize a subrecipient monitoring agreement with Boone County, Missouri to accept and appropriate funds in the amount of \$24,560.40 from the 2019 Byrne Justice Assistance Grant (JAG).

## Discussion

B313-19 dated 10/21/19 authorized the intergovernmental agreement between the City of Columbia, Missouri and County of Boone, Missouri in relation to the 2019 Byrne Justice Assistance Grant (JAG). This agreement provided the 60-40% split of available funds on an established disparity formula. This results in the city's share being \$24,560.40 of the \$40,934.00 total grant. The grant has now been awarded and must be accepted through the subrecipient monitoring agreement.

As outlined in the intergovernmental agreement, this grant will be used to purchase portable radios to replace current end-of life radios for the Police Department.

## Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: \$24,560.40 will be the Columbia Police Department's share of this grants funding. There will be no additional cost to the City for the next two years.

Long-Term Impact: No anticipated cost for the City for years beyond two.
