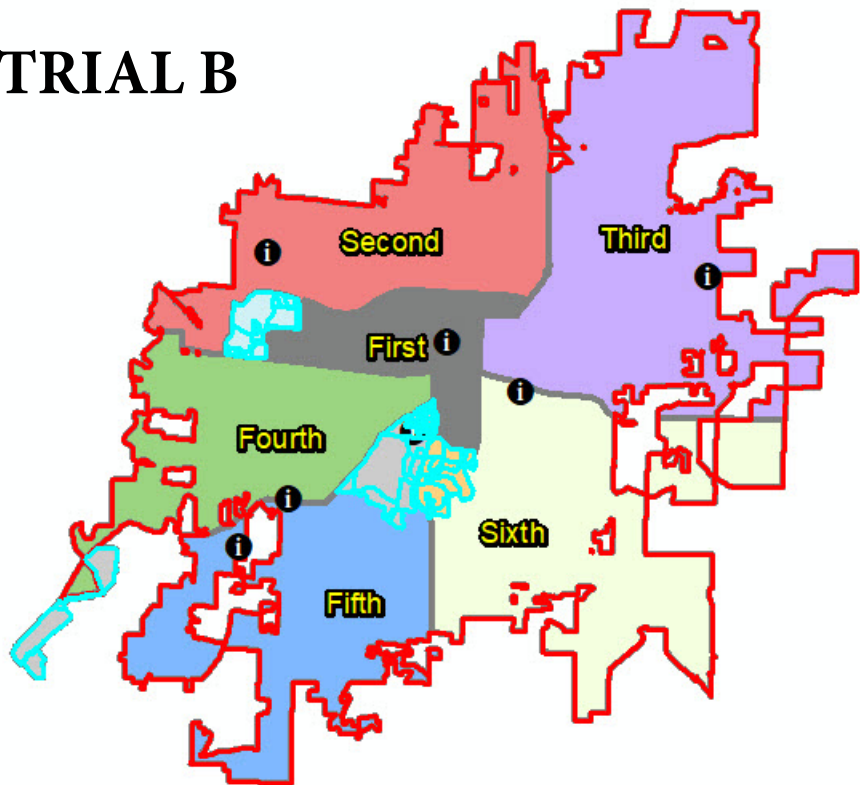

FYI:

- The 'Target Population (Average)' column is the average (sum of each Ward's population / 6) of all six Wards, as they were reported from the 2020 Census
- 'Status' - 'Gives' means that Ward has more population than the corresponding 'Target Population (Average)'
- 'Status' - 'Needs' means that Ward has less population than the corresponding 'Target Population (Average)'
- The 'Difference' column is the variance between the 'Target Population (Average)' and each Ward's current population.
- The 'Remaining' column is the 'Target Population (Average)' plus or minus the 'Final Population'
