Re: Memorandum of Understanding to establish a fire service mutual aid agreement with Fulton Fire Department.

Executive Summary

Staff requests authorization for the City Manager to sign a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the Fulton Fire Department (FFD) to establish fire service mutual aid guidelines of cooperation between the City of Columbia Fire Department and the FFD.

Discussion

The Columbia Fire Department frequently exchanges services with agencies around the region when the need arises from a significant emergency. The State of Missouri permits mutual aid between agencies to protect life and property, the agencies wish to ensure the responsibilities of both agencies are defined under state statute. This MOU defines the mutually agreed upon terms to ensure an agreement authorizing the practice of sharing resources when lives are at risk by both agencies and having a basic understanding of how they are utilized prior to an incident occurring.

The agreement establishes that there will be no requirement to reimburse either party during a request for mutual aid. The agreement waives any and all claims against each other party for damages or compensation for any loss, damage, personnel injury, death, or any other matter occurring as a consequence of performance. The agreement establishes that management and operational control of personnel will remain with the responding party.
