**AN ORDINANCE**

amending Chapter 14 of the City Code to establish two-hour parking on the north side of Elm Street between Tenth Street and Hitt Street; and fixing the time when this ordinance shall become effective.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. Chapter 14 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Columbia, Missouri, is hereby amended as follows:

Sec. 14-416. Two-hour zones.

No person shall, during the hours set forth in this division, park a vehicle in any parking space on the following designated streets or off-street parking lots, alongside of, next to, in front of, or behind which a parking meter is installed, for a longer period of time than two (2) hours at the rate established in section 14-413, except for a mobile food vendor with a meter bag issued by the public works department:

*Cherry Street*, both sides, between Fourth Street and Hitt Street.

*Elm Street*, north side, between Tenth Street and Hitt Street.

*Locust Street*, both sides, between Eighth Street and Tenth Streets.

...

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage.
