Re: Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services Participation Agreement for Tuberculosis Service Provider

## Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign the Participation Agreement between the City of Columbia and the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services for the Tuberculosis (TB) Diagnostic Services Program for the period of July 1, 2025-June 30, 2028

## Discussion

The Diagnostic Services Program provides reimbursement for the provision of tuberculosis diagnosis and control services to ensure care for patients with a positive Tuberculosis (TB) screening test.

The program provides patients who have no health insurance or are underinsured, the means to obtain diagnostic testing for Tuberculosis disease and infection. Specifically, it pays for office visits and follow-up visits, chest x-rays, x-ray interpretation, and when needed, induced sputum collection and liver function tests.

This agreement provides approximately \$5,000 annually in reimbursement for TB diagnostic services for low-income and un/underinsured individuals.

## Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: This participation agreement provides approximately \$5,000 annually in reimbursement funding. There is no impact to the general fund.
