Re: Issuance of a Liquor License to a Business Located Within 100 Feet of Church

Executive Summary

An application has been made to the State of Missouri for the issuance of a liquor license to a business located at 122 South Ninth Street called *Parks Amusements LLC dba Silverball*, which is within 100 feet of a church. Section 311.080 of the Missouri Revised Statutes requires written permission of the City Council prior to the issuance of a liquor license to this business.

Discussion

Section 311.080 of the Missouri Revised Statutes establishes that no license shall be granted for the sale of intoxicating liquor within 100 feet of any school, church or other building regularly used as a place of worship, unless the license applicant shall first obtain the written consent of the City Council. Consent also shall not be granted until written notice has been provided to all property owners within 100 feet of the proposed licensed premises, at least 10 days prior to consideration of this resolution. Such notification has been provided.

In order to prevent any confusion, Parks Amusements LLC turned over ownership of Silverball to Silverball of Columbia LLC in 2022. Parks Amusements LLC is now retaking ownership back from Silverball of Columbia LLC.
