Re: Board of Equalization City Representative Appointments

Executive Summary

This memorandum discusses appointments of City representatives to the Boone County Board of Equalization by the City Council.

Discussion

Pursuant to Section 138.015 RSMo, the City Council is authorized to appoint two city representatives to the Boone County Board of Equalization (BOE). The City-appointed members meet with representatives from the County for the purpose of equalizing assessment of property within the City. The City representatives are only entitled to hear and rule on appeals relating to property within the city limits.

At the January 4th, 2021 City Council meeting, Council appointed, by motion, Council Member Matt Pitzer and the Finance Director or his designee. Jim McDonald is the Finance Director designee representing the City. No term limits were identified, but comments had been made indicating this should be discussed again in January or February 2022.

The City Manager recommends the Finance Director's designee (Jim McDonald), continue to serve on the board.

Council Member Pitzer recommended a staff member from the Finance Department continue to serve, and that either a City Council appointed citizen with financial background or a council member would suffice for the second position. Because BOE meetings generally take place from July through September, it is suggested this be discussed annually at either the January or February City Council meeting. This timing would ensure delegates are in place before the meetings commence.
