Re: East Campus Traditional Neighborhood Association by laws and neighborhood association recognition – supplemental information

Executive Summary

The Community Development Department has received updated bylaws from the East Campus Traditional Neighborhood Association (ECTNA). Original application was tabled at the May 21, 2018 Council meeting.

Discussion

Staff has reviewed the updated bylaws submitted by the ECTNA following the tabling of their application at the May 21, 2018 Council meeting. The original bylaws contained two clauses that were of concern to Community Development:

1. Residents of rental properties were not allowed to officially join the ECTNA until they could verify that they had lived within the boundaries of the association for at least one year; and
2. Voting was limited to dues-paying members.

Both of these issues have been addressed in the updated bylaws, which now are fully compliant with the City of Columbia's Neighborhood Organization Policy.
