

Introduced by Buffaloe Council Bill No. R 30-23

A RESOLUTION

authorizing an application for federal assistance from the Recreational Trails Program for replacement of Bridges #2 and #9 on the MKT Trail.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Manager is hereby authorized to apply for federal assistance from the Recreational Trails Program for replacement of Bridges #2 and #9 on the MKT Trail.

SECTION 2. The City Manager, or the City Manager's designee, is authorized to furnish all necessary information required by the Missouri Department of Natural Resources or the Federal Highway Administration, and to sign all necessary documents on behalf of the City, in conjunction with the application.

SECTION 3. The estimated cost of this improvement is \$590,000.00. The amount of the grant applied for will be \$250,000.00 with the City providing \$340,000.00 in matching funds using Park Sales Tax Funds (\$275,000.00) and donated funds (\$65,000.00).

SECTION 4. In the event a grant is awarded, the City of Columbia will commit the necessary financial resources to operate and maintain the completed project in a safe and attractive manner for public access for a minimum of twenty-five (25) years.

SECTION 5. In the event a grant is awarded, the City of Columbia is prepared to complete the project within the time period identified on the signed project agreement.

SECTION 6. In the event a grant is awarded, the City of Columbia will comply with all rules and regulations of the Recreational Trails Program, applicable Executive Orders, all state laws that govern the grant applicant during the performance of the project, and stewardship requirements after the project is completed.
