

ADMINISTRATIVE PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

Project name and brief description: First Presbyterian Church has requested assistance from the City to share the cost of repairing sidewalk along 16 Hitt Street. The sidewalk improvements will include removing and reconstructing existing sidewalk panels and curb ramp to improve ADA accessibility. The sidewalk renovation agreement with First Presbyterian Church will allow the owner to repair the sidewalk utilizing the low bid of three bids received for the work. The City will reimburse the owner up to a not to exceed amount \$2,475.00 for the construction. Construction is planned for late summer 2025.

Estimated cost: \$4,950.00

Funding source: 1/4 cent CIP Sales Tax
