Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign the Show-Me Response Memorandum of Understanding between the Missouri State Emergency Management Agency and the City of Columbia. This agreement takes effect upon signature and ends May 31, 2021.

Discussion

This Memorandum of Understanding establishes a partnership between the Missouri State Emergency Management Agency and the City of Columbia in support of the Columbia/Boone County Medical Reserve Corps. The focus of this agreement is to develop and maintain a registry of volunteer health professionals and other volunteers who can be activated to assist with federal, state, and /or local emergency response activities. Public Health and Human Services coordinates this effort locally.
