Re: Authorizing an agreement with Consolidated Public Water Supply District #1 to transfer water customers located along North Stadium Boulevard to the Columbia Water Utility.

Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration an ordinance authorizing the City Manager to execute an agreement with Consolidated Public Water Supply District #1 (CPWSD #1) to transfer existing customers to the Columbia Water Utility.

Discussion

Staff has prepared for Council consideration an ordinance authorizing the City Manager to execute an agreement with Consolidated Public Water Supply District #1 (CPWSD #1) to transfer 10 existing customers to the Columbia Water Utility. The 10 existing CPWSD #1 customers are located along North Stadium Boulevard between Sunflower Drive and Rocky Fork Creek as shown on the attached diagram.

In 2014, the CPWSD #1 water main that served these 10 customers broke near the Rocky Fork Creek. Rather than construct a new water main across Rock Fork Creek, CPWSD #1 was allowed to connect the customers to the City's system. The City has been providing water to CPWSD #1 for these 10 customers since that time.

The 1998 Water Service Territorial Agreement between the City and CPWSD #1 identifies the area along North Stadium Boulevard between Sunflower Drive and Rocky Fork Creek as City water service territory, as shown on the attached diagram. In addition, there are provisions in the 1998 territorial agreement that allow CPWSD #1 and the City to transfer water customers in these types of situations.

As part of the customer transfer agreement, CPWSD #1 will convey their water lines, appurtenances and easements in the area to the City.
