

VII REPORTS AND PETITIONS

a) Request for permission to erect awning at 804 E. Broadway, by David Bear, III

Mr. Snyder stated that the Council now has the discretion to grant a permit only for a free-standing concrete canopy. The amendment would allow the Council to grant permits for other type canopies or awnings, etc. in the area of the downtown.

Mayor Wilson stated that Mr. Bear has proceeded with a lease based on the assumption that there would be a particular type of marquee erected.

Mr. David Bear, III, 804 E. Broadway, stated that he wants to build a stained glass, half Tiffany shade awning at this location. He stated his building is to be completed August 1, but he needs to know if he should proceed with the construction of this awning and while he realizes the Council cannot make the final decision at this meeting, he would be able to get an idea of what he should do.

Mayor Wilson stated that the two concerns he knows of with the awning is that it be structurally sound and the other is that it not interfere with fire fighting abilities. He asked Mr. Beck if he had any comments on this item.

Mr. Beck stated they are interested in the liability aspect of this type awning. He stated the ordinance was written so there would be some uniformity in the construction of this type thing.

Mr. Bear stated he would agree to whatever liability insurance the Council would agree on.

No one on the Council objected to Mr. Bear proceeding with his awning.

b) Wehmeyer Drive petition

Mayor Wilson stated the staff is requesting the staff to approve the report which instructs the staff to proceed with the drawings for the construction. Mayor Wilson made a motion to approve the report and direct the staff to proceed with detailed construction plans and drawings. Mr. Goodrich seconded the motion and the motion was approved unanimously with voice vote.

VIII APPOINTMENTS TO BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS

a) Appointment to Board of Equalization

On motion of Mayor Wilson, seconded by Mr. Smith, the Finance Director was appointed to this Board, by unanimous voice vote.

IX COMMENTS OF COUNCIL, STAFF AND PUBLIC

Mr. Vaughan stated that over a year ago the Council was suppose to get a traffic light at 5th & Providence and there have been delays with the Highway Department. He would like to have a report from Mr. Beck explaining the status of this light and what efforts the City has gone to in order to get this light so we can share this information with the public and see what the holdups are.

Mr. Beck stated that he will submit this report to the Council.

Paul Albert, no address given, gave comments concerning the appointment of acting city manager, West Broadway widening, and the citizens survey.
