

A RESOLUTION

expressing support for the proposed construction of a housing development to be located near the intersection of International Drive and Edenton Drive and associated application to the Missouri Housing Development Commission for low income housing tax credits; authorizing a letter of support.

WHEREAS, the City Council deems it in the public interest and general welfare of the City that safe, affordable, quality homes be made available to citizens impacted by mental illness, substance abuse and other disabling conditions in the City of Columbia; and

WHEREAS, Burrell Behavioral Health will submit to the Missouri Housing Development Commission a request for consideration of award of Low Income Housing Tax Credits necessary to finance the development and construction of a new housing development located near the intersection of International Drive and Edenton Drive consisting of up to twenty-four (24) apartment units with supportive housing designed to provide affordable rental housing for citizens impacted by mental illness, substance abuse and other disabling conditions who are 18-years-of-age and older.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City of Columbia hereby supports the application made by Burrell Behavioral Health to the Missouri Housing Development Commission for Low Income Housing Tax Credits for construction of a new housing development located near the intersection of International Drive and Edenton Drive consisting of up to twenty-four (24) apartment units designed to provide affordable rental housing for citizens impacted by mental illness, substance abuse and other disabling conditions who are 18-years-of-age and older.

SECTION 2. The City Council hereby authorizes Mayor Treece to provide a letter of support to Burrell Behavioral Health for the proposed housing development project.
