

Introduced by Treece Council Bill No. R 165-18

A RESOLUTION

setting a public hearing; declaring the necessity for the proposed construction of improvements at the Lions-Stephens Park to include replacement of the existing shelter and playground structures, installation of a sidewalk along Ann Street, installation of concrete pads for trash and recycling receptacles, construction of ADA walkways and the installation of additional amenities as funding allows; stating the nature of and the estimate of the cost of the proposed improvements; providing source of funds for payment for the proposed improvements; and providing for compliance with the prevailing wage law.

WHEREAS, an interested parties meeting for the proposed construction of improvements at the Lions-Stephens Park to include replacement of the existing shelter and playground structures, installation of a sidewalk along Ann Street, installation of concrete pads for trash and recycling receptacles, construction of ADA walkways and the installation of additional amenities as funding allows was held by the Parks and Recreation Department on September 18, 2018.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. A public hearing in respect to the proposed public improvements set forth herein will be held in the Council Chamber of the City Hall Building, 701 E. Broadway, Columbia, Missouri, at 7:00 p.m. on November 19, 2018. The City Clerk shall cause notice of this hearing to be published in a newspaper published in the City.

SECTION 2. The City Council deems the proposed construction of improvements at the Lions-Stephens Park to include replacement of the existing shelter and playground structures, installation of a sidewalk along Ann Street, installation of concrete pads for trash and recycling receptacles, construction of ADA walkways and the installation of additional amenities as funding allows, necessary to the welfare and improvement of the City but desires to hear from the public prior to taking further action to authorize construction of the project.

SECTION 3. The nature and scope of the proposed improvements shall consist of furnishing all labor, materials, transportation, insurance and all other items, accessories and incidentals thereto necessary for the complete construction of the improvements. Following the public hearing the City Council shall determine whether it is in the public interest to make the proposed public improvements or any part thereof.

SECTION 4. The estimated cost of this proposed improvement project is \$100,000.00.

SECTION 5. Payment for the proposed improvements shall be made from park sales tax funds and such other funds as may be lawfully appropriated.

SECTION 6. Any work done in connection with the construction of the proposed improvements specified above shall be in compliance with the provisions of the prevailing wage laws of the State of Missouri.
