Re: Repealing B92-20 RE: Provisions Related to Temporary Suspension of Transportation Fares

Executive Summary

As the reopening process begins, staff will reinstate the process of charging fares for Transit Services. Accordingly, an Ordinance has been prepared to repeal Section 4 of B92-20 (Ordinance No. 024211) to lift the temporary suspension of transportation fares.

Discussion

Staff is recommending Council repeal B92-20 Section 4, which discusses changes related to Section 22-29, provisions relating to payment of transportation fares temporarily waived. Repealing B92-20 Section 4 will lift the waiver as of July 7, 2020 and staff would begin charging transportation fares again, as prior to the adoption of B92-20.
