Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign the Participation Agreement between the City of Columbia and the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services for the Tuberculosis (TB) Diagnostic Services Program for the period of July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2019.
