

ADMINISTRATIVE PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

Project name and brief description: Cosmo-Bethel Park: Small Shelter Replacement – The Parks and Recreation Department is proposing to use a combination of contract and force account labor to replace the small shelter adjacent to the playground at Cosmo-Bethel Park. The small shelter was constructed in 1985 as part of a larger playground improvement project in partnership with the Columbia Cosmopolitan Luncheon Club. Park staff will complete the demolition of the existing shelter and connecting walkways. Contract labor will be used to pour the concrete for the shelter pad and walkway connections. Park staff will finish the project with the installation of a pre-fab metal shelter. The shelter size will closely match the size of the existing shelter. As budgeted in the City’s FY-2019 CIP, the improvements will be funded by the 2015 Park Sales Tax. The replacement of the small shelter is anticipated to be completed by late spring 2019.

Estimated cost: \$25,000

Funding source: Park Sales Tax
