

Introduced by Buffaloe Council Bill No. R 79-25

A RESOLUTION

authorizing the temporary closures of portions of sidewalk on the west side of Eighth Street and the south side of Broadway, and certain parking stalls on the south side of Broadway and the west side of Eighth Street, to facilitate exterior repairs to the Central Bank building.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Council hereby authorizes Central Bank the temporary closures of sidewalks and certain parking stalls from June 3, 2025 through August 22, 2025, as shown on "Exhibit A" attached hereto, to facilitate exterior repairs to the Central Bank building as follows:

1. Closure of a portion of the sidewalk along the west side of Eighth Street between Broadway and Cherry Street.
2. Closure of a portion of the sidewalk along the south side of Broadway between Seventh Street and Eighth Street.
3. Closure of certain parking stalls adjacent to the Central Bank building located on the south side of Broadway and the west side of Eighth Street.


SECTION 2. Central Bank shall close the sidewalks and parking stalls only in accordance with the traffic control plans submitted and approved by the City's Director of Public Works. In the interest of public safety, the Director of Public Works may require additional traffic control measures by notifying Central Bank, in writing, of such requirements. Central Bank shall be responsible for all signs and barricades necessary for the protection and convenience of the general public and shall be responsible for the repair or replacement of the sidewalks and parking stalls due to any damage caused by the construction activity. Central Bank shall be responsible for notifications to the media and emergency personnel.

SECTION 3. Central Bank shall proceed with construction activities which require the temporary sidewalk and parking stall closures without unnecessary delay so as to minimize disruption to the public. Failure to proceed without unnecessary delay may result in the revocation of the closure permit by the City Council.

SECTION 4. The temporary closures authorized herein may be terminated by the City Council upon recommendation of the Director of Public Works and a determination such are no longer necessary for the protection of the health, safety and welfare of the public or is otherwise in the best interest of the public.


