Re: COVID-19 Temporary Housing Agreement for First Responders

Executive Summary

This resolution authorizes the City Manager to sign the agreement and any time extensions needed for Temporary Housing for First Responders due to COVID-19 pandemic between Stephens College and the City of Columbia, Missouri.

Discussion

This agreement between Stephens College and the City of Columbia, Missouri allows City of Columbia First Responders (Police and Fire employees) optional temporary housing during the COVID-19 pandemic, should the need arise.

This agreement expires on June 1, 2020 with the ability to extend upon mutual agreement of the parties. This resolution would give the City Manager the authority to sign and extend the agreement with Stephens College to provide Temporary Housing for First Responders, if needed.
