

ADMINISTRATIVE PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

Project name and brief description: Cosmo Park: Roller Hockey Rink Resurfacing Project: Park staff is proposing to use contract labor to resurface the roller hockey rink in Columbia Cosmopolitan Recreation Area (Cosmo Park). The steps in the resurfacing project include cleaning the entire court surface, repairing all asphalt cracks using a specialized process to seal all existing cracks, leveling all low areas using a high tensile acrylic leveler and applying three coats of acrylic skate on surfacing product to restore the roller hockey rink to the desired condition of facility users. The final step in the process is to repaint the hockey rink lines on the rink surface to standard hockey specifications. The contractor will also paint the oval necessary for roller derby use of the rink. The courts have not been resurfaced since 2014. The entire process for the roller hockey rink resurfacing project is expected to take two weeks and will need to occur when under warmer temperatures. In 2019, Council approved a \$40,000 project to resurface 4 tennis courts at Cosmo Park and in early 2020, we received a \$14,000 USTA grant to assist with the resurfacing. Staff is requesting using the \$22,680 tennis court resurfacing balance to resurface the Cosmo Park Roller Hockey Rink. This project has been requested by multiple users in the past year especially since the closing of the indoor roller rinks. Staff anticipates completion of the work in spring 2021 after bidding the project through the Purchasing Department.

Estimated cost: \$22,680

Funding source: Park Sales Tax
