Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration an ordinance authorizing changes to Sec 27-106 Renewable Energy Standard of the City Code of Ordinances. At the May 21 City Council meeting, Councilman Pitzer asked for an amendment to Sec 27-106 Renewable Energy Standard of the City Code of Ordinances to change the wording from "electric retail sales" to "electric retail usage".

Discussion

At the October 3, 2018 Water & Light Advisory Board meeting, the board approved a proposal to change Sec 27-106 Renewable Energy Standard of the City Code of Ordinances by replacing "electric retail sales" with "electric retail usage" and "electricity purchased" with "electricity produced".
