

Introduced by Buffaloe Council Bill No. R 58-26

A RESOLUTION

setting a public hearing; declaring the necessity for the proposed replacement and improvement of storm drainage infrastructure along portions of Braemore Road, Highland Drive, Summit Road, and Fairview Road; stating the nature of and the estimate of the cost of the proposed improvement; providing source of funds for payment for the proposed improvement; and providing for compliance with the prevailing wage law.

WHEREAS, an interested parties meeting for the proposed replacement and improvement of storm drainage infrastructure along portions of Braemore Road, Highland Drive, Summit Road, and Fairview Road was held by the Utilities Department – Sewer/Stormwater Division on April 15, 2025.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. A public hearing in respect to the proposed public improvements set forth herein will be held in the Council Chamber of the City Hall Building, 701 E. Broadway, Columbia, Missouri, at 7:00 p.m. on May 4, 2026. The City Clerk shall cause notice of this hearing to be published in a newspaper published in the City.

SECTION 2. The City Council deems the proposed replacement and improvement of storm drainage infrastructure along portions of Braemore Road, Highland Drive, Summit Road, and Fairview Road necessary to the welfare and improvement of the City but desires to hear from the public prior to taking further action to authorize construction of the project. Specific improvements include construction of approximately 890 linear feet of new conveyance pipe, construction or replacement of twelve (12) stormwater structures, and the rehabilitation of approximately 660 linear feet of existing stormwater pipe and three (3) existing stormwater inlets.

SECTION 3. The nature and scope of the proposed improvement shall consist of furnishing all labor, materials, transportation, insurance and all other items, accessories and incidentals thereto necessary for the complete construction of the improvements. Following the public hearing the City Council shall determine whether it is in the public interest to make the proposed public improvements or any part thereof.


SECTION 4. The estimated cost of this proposed improvement is \$2,150,000.00.

SECTION 5. Payment for this proposed improvement shall be made from the Storm Water Utility Fund and such other funds as may be lawfully appropriated.

SECTION 6. Any work done in connection with the construction of the proposed improvement specified above shall be in compliance with the provisions of the prevailing wage laws of the State of Missouri.
