Re: Authorizing the Temporary Closure of Sidewalk on the West Side of South Fifth Street between Elm Street and East Stewart Road.

Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration a resolution authorizing the University of Missouri to close a portion of sidewalk along South Fifth Street between Elm Street and East Stewart Road from August 3, 2020 to September 30, 2020.

Discussion

The University of Missouri is seeking permission for the temporary closure of approximately one hundred and eighty (180) linear feet of sidewalk on the west side of South Fifth Street, between Elm Street and East Stewart Road, from August 3, 2020 to September 30, 2020. The closure is being requested so that masonry restoration and repairs can be performed on the east elevation of the Gas Turbine Building located at 417 South Fifth Street. There are no adjacent businesses or residences along South Fifth Street at this location.

The University of Missouri and/or its contractor will be responsible for all signs and barricades necessary for the protection and convenience of the general public; see attached traffic control plan. The University of Missouri is exempt from any public inconvenience fee.
