Re: Authorizing a Tourism Development Sponsorship Agreement with The Curators of the

University of Missouri for the University Concert Series

Executive Summary

The University of Missouri Concert Series presented a Tourism Development Signature Series funding application to the Convention & Visitors Bureau (CVB) Advisory Board on July 28, 2025, requesting support to help cover artist fees for its 118th season.

Discussion

A cornerstone of Mid-Missouri's performing arts community for more than a century, the University Concert Series has consistently delivered diverse performances designed to educate, engage, and entertain audiences. The upcoming season will feature 15–18 nationally recognized touring acts, along with a dedicated event for University students. This marks a significant expansion from last year's abbreviated season.

In addition to its main performances, the Concert Series provides valuable community outreach each year. This includes collaborations with the Missoula Children's Theatre that offer local elementary and high school students the opportunity to participate in the performing arts. The organization also donates hundreds of tickets annually to local nonprofits and charitable groups, broadening community access to live performances.

Following its review of the application, the CVB Advisory Board voted to recommend allocating \$12,500 in Tourism Development Funds to assist with artist fees for the 118th season of the University Concert Series.
