## Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign the Boone County Agreement for Purchase of Services to develop the Boone County Food Policy Council, effective January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020 in the amount of \$30,000.00; appropriating funds.

## Discussion

Public Health and Human Services is receiving support from the Boone County Community Health Fund to develop the newly-formed Boone County Food Policy Council by creating Food Policy Plan and educational resources. The plan will identify and promote food policy priorities based on best-practice and community data and increase access to healthy food.

Funding for this project was not anticipated in the FY20 budget. An appropriation is necessary.
