Re: Approval of an operations agreement with FPC Live, LLC for the production of a series of 9th Street Summerfest Events as outlined in Section 24-73 of City Code

Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration a resolution granting approval of an operations agreement with FPC Live, LLC for the production of a series of 9th Street Summerfest events; to include waiver of the open container ordinance and the approval to close 9th Street from Walnut to Broadway.

Discussion

Per Section 24-73 (b) of the City Code, '...the City Event Committee shall not approve closing any area as set out in subsection (a) above or for any of the following...(1) The day before, or the day of, any scheduled University of Missouri home football game... Any closures of this kind shall require an agreement negotiated by the city manager with the event organizer and the agreement must be approved by the city council.'

Mike Nolan, General Manager of The Blue Note dba FPC Live, LLC, is requesting a closure of 9th Street, from Walnut to Broadway, and a waiver of the open container ordinance on 9th Street, from Walnut to Broadway, from 6:30 p.m. until 11:00 p.m., on the following dates:

- August 31, 2018
- September 8, 2018 (day of MU v. Wyoming)
- September 21, 2018 (day prior to MU v. GA)

The Event Services Specialist and the organizer negotiated terms for an operations agreement including a waiver from the requirements of Sec. 16-185 and closure of 9th Street on the dates of, or prior to, a University of Missouri home football game as outlined in Sec. 24-73, security plan, alcohol sales, and layout of the event.
