Re: Amending Chapter 14 of the Code of Ordinances - Immobilization of Vehicles for Unpaid Parking Tickets

Executive Summary

Amending Chapter 14 of the Code of Ordinances to broaden the definition of a vehicle immobilization device.

Discussion

In cooperation with the City Prosecutor and Municipal Court staff, Public Works staff has drafted a revision to Section 14-312 - Immobilization of vehicles for unpaid parking tickets. As written, the current ordinance is specific to the use of a "mechanical boot" as the only device used to immobilize a vehicle. This language restricts the use of new and future equipment and technologies used in the parking industry; therefore, staff is proposing to revise this section of the ordinance to replace the outdated "mechanical boot" with immobilization device.
