Executive Summary

A resolution authorizing the City Manager to sign an agreement with the Missouri Conservation Heritage Foundation for the period of the effective date to December 31, 2026 for the amount of \$45,606.

Discussion

City of Columbia will collaborate with partners to develop a One Health model for Boone County aligned with the Missouri Foundation for Health Grant awarded to Missouri Conservation Heritage Foundation. One Health is a movement to align human and environmental health. PHHS will lead a community engagement process, conduct focus groups and do qualitative analysis. The Director of City Parks and Recreation and a representative from PHHS will serve on the steering committee to help guide the process.
