Re: Central Missouri Humane Society relocation proposal

Executive Summary

The Central Missouri Humane Society (CMHS) is requesting to relocate from its present location on Big Bear Blvd to a new location on Strawn Road.

Discussion

CMHS is requesting to swap city land at 616 Big Bear Blvd. (2.88 acres) on which the CMHS is currently located for 4.06 acres on Strawn Road where a future facility can be built. This land is part of the 47-acre tract donated to the City by Larry Potterfield.

The CMHS has completed a needs assessment of its current facility, location, and anticipated growth. The CMHS has established a feasibility study committee to help develop a set of specific strategic priorities for a capital campaign and desires to enter into a memorandum of understanding with the City in order to move forward with the campaign.
