Re: Report: Proposed Recycling Drop Off Center on City-owned property on Oakland Gravel Road.

Executive Summary

Staff has prepared a report regarding the proposed Recycling Drop Off Center on City-owned property on Oakland Gravel Road as shown on the attached map. An Interested Parties (IP) meeting was held November 23, 2021 and a second IP meeting was held on December 7, 2021.

Discussion

On April 19, 2021, Council authorized staff to proceed with preliminary design to determine the feasibility and cost associated with constructing a new recycling drop off center on City-owned property on Oakland Gravel Road as shown on the attached diagram.

An IP meeting was held on November 23, 2021 and a second IP meeting was held on December 7, 2021. A total of 10 citizens attended the two IP meetings. A total of 22 comments were received. Six comments were in favor of the project and 16 comments were not in favor of the project. All of the 16 negative comments were concerned with traffic impacts. Citizens voiced concerns with the current traffic conditions at the Vandiver and Oakland Gravel Road and Vandiver and Paris Road intersections.

Due to the overwhelming opposition of those citizens who provided comments on the project, staff is proposing to not move forward with this project and to remove the project from the CIP.
