amplified family-friendly music for Rader Hospitality, LLC.

Executive Summary

This resolution is to amend the date of an event from August 22, 2022 to October 12, 2022 contained in R113-22 as approved by Council on August 1, 2022.

Discussion

At the August 1, 2022 Council meeting, R113-22 received approval for the waiver from the requirements of Section 16-185 and 16-258.1 from 5:00 p.m. until 11:59 p.m. for an event on Monday, August 22, 2022. Due to a date change by the artist, this event has been moved to Wednesday, October 12, 2022. The entertainment for this event will remain contained to the event organizer's parcel located at 119 S. Seventh Street.

This includes a waiver from the requirements of Section 16-185 of the City Code to allow possession and consumption of alcoholic beverages, a waiver from the requirements of Section 16-258.1 of the City Code to allow amplified family-friendly music for the event, and a closure of the alley between Sixth and Seventh Streets.
