

**AMENDMENT NO. 1
TO
AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI
AND ENGINEERING SURVEYS AND SERVICES**

**SANITARY SEWER UTILITY
FLAT BRANCH WATERSHED RELIEF SEWER, PROJECT #3
COLUMBIA, MISSOURI**

THIS AMENDMENT NO. 1 made as of _____ day of _____, 2017 modifies the Agreement between the City of Columbia, Missouri (CITY) and Engineering Surveys and Services, (ENGINEER) dated September 17, 2014 (Agreement).

1. ENGINEER shall provide engineering services in connection with the Flat Branch Watershed Relief Sewer, Project #3; and
2. ENGINEER shall perform additional engineering services required due to several items that were not in the original scope of services summarized as follows: Since final plans were received dated June 1, 2016, a new section of sanitary sewer has been constructed along Elm Street between 5th and 6th Streets by a private developer. The plans were revised to incorporate this new pipe. The plans were also revised to show the Flat Branch Project #1 changes near the University power plant driveway and a new sewer connection at 9th Street. The work is also to include construction staking of the project.
3. CITY shall pay ENGINEER a fee not to exceed Thirty Five Thousand dollars (\$35,000.00) for the additional services; and
4. The terms and conditions of the Agreement are modified as specifically set forth herein. All other provisions of the Agreement, to the extent not inconsistent with this Amendment, remain in full force and effect.
