Re: Correction to Memo Regarding End User License Agreement with Schneider Electric, LLC.

Executive Summary

The previous memo indicated an incorrect contracted cost of \$192,075. The correct cost in accordance with the contract documents is \$170,918.

Discussion

The City of Columbia solicited a request for proposals (RFP) 56/2017 seeking vendors for a new SCADA system to be used at the Water Treatment Plant through the Purchasing Division. Based on proposal evaluations, Schneider Electric was selected as the vendor to provide the Wonderware software. This agreement serves as the EULA specifying the licensing and terms of use for this software by the City. This agreement is solely a license agreement and not an agreement for sale.
