Executive Summary

A resolution authorizing the City Manager to sign a second amendment to the agreement for services between The Food Bank for Central & Northeast Missouri, Inc. and the City of Columbia, MO

Discussion

The City of Columbia received \$25.2 million in American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds to address the public health and economic impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic. On October 2, 2023, the City Council approved a resolution (R154-23) that instructed staff to negotiate agreements for Council consideration utilizing the ARPA funds. On December 4, 2023 Council authorized the City Manager to sign an agreement (R198-23) with The Food Bank for Central & Northeast Missouri, Inc. to address access to services. On October 21, 2024 Council Authorized the City Manager to sign a first amendment to the agreement (R182-24) with the Food Bank for Central and Northeast Missouri, Inc increasing the total amount of the agreement from \$500,000 to \$633,333.33 and increase the pounds of food provided to City of Columbia households.

On August 4, 2025 Council authorized the City Manager to sign a second amendment to the agreement ([R108-25](#)) with Big Brothers Big Sisters of Central Missouri reducing their total award amount from \$225,000 to \$112,500, leaving \$112,500 of ARPA funds available for reallocation. Amendment 02 of the agreement with the Food Bank for Central & Northeast Missouri, Inc reallocates \$50,000 of those surplus funds, increasing the costs not to exceed from \$633,333.33 to \$683,333.33. All other terms and conditions remain the same.
