Re: Parks and Recreation Appropriation Request

Executive Summary

The Parks and Recreation Department is requesting City Council action to appropriate funds in the total amount of \$85,000 from a Parks and Recreation donation account for their intended use. The donation of funds will be used to offset the costs associated with the purchase of the bridge for the Flat Branch Park expansion capital improvement project. Details of the project are highlighted in the discussion section.

Discussion

The Department is requesting \$85,000 in donated funds be appropriated to the Flat Branch Park expansion capital improvement project. The project was approved by the City Council on March 15, 2021 and includes site reclamation, demolition completion, bridge installation, sidewalk installation, lighting, creek restoration, and landscaping. The Mayor's Task Force on Bicentennial Celebration was tasked with raising funds for the installation of the bridge connecting the parkland over the Flat Branch Creek. Along with raising \$85,000 in donations for the purchase of the bridge, the task force secured an in-kind donation from Emery Sapp & Sons to construct the bridge endwalls and set the new bridge in place. Staff will bid the bridge through the City's Purchasing Department and anticipates completion of the Flat Branch Park expansion project by late spring 2023.

Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: The appropriation, totaling \$85,000, will be used to reimburse the capital project account for the corresponding expenditure for the bridge. Staff does not anticipate an adverse fiscal impact associated with the appropriation, and all funds will be spent for their intended use.
