

Introduced by Buffaloe Council Bill No. R 58-24

A RESOLUTION

authorizing the City Manager, or designee, to grant permission to commercial and industrial electric customers to participate in emergency demand response resource programs implemented and administered by the Midcontinent Independent System Operator (MISO) and approving the form of such authorization.

WHEREAS, the MISO electric tariffs filed with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission provide for certain processes and procedures for an end use customer of an electric utility to be used as an emergency demand response resource; and

WHEREAS, such tariffs require the aggregator who facilitates the end use customer's participation as an emergency demand response resource to certify that the laws, regulations, or orders of the City permit such activity by the end use customer; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to authorize the City Manager, or designee, to consider the impact of the participation of an end use customer on the operation of the electric utility upon request of such customer to ensure such participation does not have an adverse effect on such operations.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The City Manager, or designee, is authorized to grant permission to commercial and industrial electric customers of the City to participate in emergency demand response programs implemented and administered by the Midcontinent Independent System Operator (MISO). Such permission shall be provided on an authorization form maintained by the electric utility in substantially the same form as set forth in "Exhibit A" which is attached to and made a part of this resolution.
