Re: Contract with MO DHSS to increase adult vaccination rates.

Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign the COVID-19 and Adult Vaccination Supplemental Amendment 02 program services contract with the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services.

Discussion

This agreement provides funding from Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services to support local efforts to plan, develop and maintain a public health workforce to increase COVID-19 and adult vaccination capacity across jurisdictions, including among high-risk and underserved populations; ensure high-quality and safe administration of vaccines; ensure equitable distribution and administration of vaccines; increase vaccine confidence through education, outreach and partnerships; develop and implement community engagement strategies to promote vaccination efforts and utilize immunization information systems to support efficient vaccination efforts. The amendment will provide \$161,193 in additional funding and extend the contract period through June 30, 2025.
