Re: Supplemental Memo related to Council Bill 367-19 authorizing Construction and Installation of a "New Design" Bus Shelter on the South Side of Broadway and West of Garth Avenue

Executive Summary

Council Bill 367-19 authorizing construction and installation of a "New Design" bus shelter on the south side of Broadway and west of Garth Avenue and calling for bids for a portion of the project through the Purchasing Division, included specification and details that were developed in 2014, and referenced COMO Connect as the City's transit system. Due to a settlement agreement, the City has agreed to no longer utilize this name so staff has redacted wherever COMO Connect was referenced in the original specification and details.

Discussion

The 2014 specifications and details that were attached to Council Bill 367-19 referenced COMO Connect as the official name of the transit system. Staff was required to redact the name due to a settlement agreement wherein the City agreed to no longer utilize COMO Connect in reference to our transit system. Attached is a copy of the redacted 2014 specifications and details.
