Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign Amendment #01 to the Tobacco Control Coalition Contract between the City of Columbia and the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services in an amount not to exceed \$7,203 for the period of March 30, 2016 through March 29, 2017; appropriating funds.

Discussion

This contract allows the Healthy Lifestyles Action Team to support an active community smoke-free coalition to educate the community on the benefits of living smoke free. The Healthy Lifestyles Action Team is made up of community partners, formed following the results of a community health assessment, to address healthy eating, physical activity, and tobacco use. The additional funding will be used for community education.
