Re: Placing portions of the Code of Federal Regulations and Code of State Regulations with regard to Pretreatment Regulations on file with the City Clerk.

### Executive Summary

Staff has prepared a resolution for Council consideration that authorizes Parts 403 through 471 of the Code of Federal Regulations and 10 CSR 20-6.100 of the Code of State Regulations regarding Pretreatment Regulation to be placed on file with the City Clerk.

### Discussion

The Missouri Department of Natural Resources (MDNR) issued the City of Columbia Missouri a State Operating Permit #MO-0097837 for the Columbia Wastewater Treatment Plant effective July 1, 2020. The permit requires the City to implement and enforce an approved pretreatment program. Section F, Special Conditions, of the permit required a technical evaluation of the need to revise local limits. It has been determined the local limits will need to be revised and the proposed updates are in the MDNR review process. Once review and approval is obtained from MDNR, it will be necessary to update and revise existing pretreatment program ordinances contained in the City Code to incorporate applicable federal and state regulations. Section 67.280 of the Missouri Statutes requires the City to place one copy of the pertinent Federal and State Codes on file in the office of the City Clerk for a period of ninety (90) days, prior to consideration of adoption by reference in the City Code.
