Re: Authorizing a subrecipient monitoring agreement with Boone County, Missouri in relation to the acceptance of funds for the 2022 Byrne Justice Assistance Grant (JAG)

Executive Summary

Staff has prepared for Council consideration an ordinance to authorize a subrecipient monitoring agreement with Boone County, Missouri to accept funds in the amount of \$21,777.00 from the 2022 Byrne Justice Assistance Grant (JAG).

Discussion

B298-22 dated 10/17/2022 authorized the intergovernmental agreement between the City of Columbia, Missouri and County of Boone, Missouri in relation to the 2022 Byrne Justice Assistance Grant (JAG). The intergovernmental agreement provides the 60-40% split of available funds on an established disparity formula. This results in the city's share being \$21,777.00 of the \$36,925.00 total grant. The grant has been awarded and must be accepted through the subrecipient monitoring agreement.

As outlined in the intergovernmental agreement, this grant will be used to purchase portable radios to replace current end-of life radios for the Police Department

Fiscal Impact

Short-Term Impact: \$21,777.00 will be the Columbia Police Department's share of this grants funding. Both the revenue and expense were included in the current FY2023 police budget. Long-Term Impact: No anticipated cost for the City for years beyond two.
