Re: Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services Participation Agreement – State Investment in Local Public Health Services

Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign the Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services for State Investment in Local Public Health Services contract. The agreement period is June 1, 2024 through May 31, 2027.

Discussion

This agreement allows the Columbia / Boone County Department of Public Health and Human Services (PHHS) to receive funding from the State of Missouri for local public health services. In addition to Missouri General Revenue, local public health agencies receive some reimbursement from Medicaid for conducting certain children's health activities. This agreement has been in effect since 2013. The Missouri Department of Health and Senior Services requires an MOU in addition to the Participation Agreement clarifying the requirements of local public health agencies in receiving a portion of the Medicaid funds.
