

A RESOLUTION

setting a public hearing; declaring the necessity for proposed construction of sanitary sewer rehabilitation project #9 in the Business Loop 70 and downtown areas; stating the nature of and the estimate of the cost of the proposed improvements; providing source of funds for payment for the proposed improvements; and providing for compliance with the prevailing wage law.

WHEREAS, interested parties meetings for the proposed construction of sanitary sewer rehabilitation project #9 in the Business Loop 70 and downtown areas was held by the City Utilities Department – Sewer/Stormwater Division on November 9, 2021.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF COLUMBIA, MISSOURI, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. A public hearing in respect to the proposed public improvements set forth herein will be held in the Council Chamber of the City Hall Building, 701 E. Broadway, Columbia, Missouri, at 7:00 p.m. on December 20, 2021. The City Clerk shall cause notice of this hearing to be published in a newspaper published in the City.

SECTION 2. The City Council deems the proposed construction of sanitary sewer rehabilitation project #9 in the Business Loop 70 and downtown areas, which involves the rehabilitation of approximately 75,000 linear feet of sewer line and associated sewer structures, necessary to the welfare and improvement of the City.

SECTION 3. The nature and scope of the proposed improvements shall consist of furnishing all labor, materials, transportation, insurance and all other items, accessories and incidentals thereto necessary for the complete construction of the improvements.

SECTION 4. The estimated cost of the proposed improvements is \$3,025,000.00.

SECTION 5. Payment for the proposed improvements shall be made from Sanitary Sewer revenue bond funds, sewer revenue funds, and such other funds as may be lawfully appropriated.

SECTION 6. Any work done in connection with the construction of the proposed improvements specified above shall be in compliance with the provisions of the prevailing wage laws of the State of Missouri.
