

ADMINISTRATIVE PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

Project name and brief description: This project will include construction of a pedestrian island on the south side of Ash Street at the midblock crosswalk between 5th Street and 6th Street. There is an existing mid-block crosswalk at this location that connects the post office to their employee parking lot. Just east of the crosswalk on the south side of the road, there is a tree that obstructs the view of the pedestrian crossing sign and pedestrians waiting at the crosswalk in the summertime. The construction of the pedestrian island will allow pedestrians to stand in the crosswalk by the island and the pedestrian crossing sign to be relocated to the island. This improvement will increase the visibility and awareness of pedestrians crossing the street for vehicles traveling eastbound on Ash Street. The City term and supply contract will be used to construct the island and relocated the sign. Construction is planned for this spring.

Department: Public Works

Estimated cost: \$5,000

Funding source: Street Operations
