Re: Purchase of Service Agreement with Boone County, Missouri for Perinatal Distress Provider Training

Executive Summary

An ordinance authorizing the City Manager to sign the Purchase of Services Agreement between Boone County, Missouri and the City of Columbia for Perinatal Distress Provider Training; appropriating funds.

Discussion

The Boone County Children’s Services Board would like to purchase services provided by Public Health and Human Services. This contract specifically identifies services of increasing provider confidence in addressing perinatal distress training program for service providers with children and youth nineteen years of age or less and their families. The funding provides scholarships for both two and three day trainings, and the amount shall not exceed \$19,925.
